The Rokewood Corindhap Football Netball Club will actively promote the safety and wellbeing of children and young people, recognising the need for community football clubs to take direct responsibility for providing a safe physical and online environment for children and young people in their care.

All appointed Coaches, Team Managers, Umpires , Canteen Managers and Committee Members must have a current working with children check. We also strongly encourage all senior players to have a current WWC.
